- Submit online application
- Official transcripts from all previously attended institutions

Online Program Structure

- 3 starts each year: spring, summer, and fall
- Full-time completion option: Four 8-week terms courses, complete in as few as 12 months (2 semesters)
- Part-time completion option: Eight 8-weeks terms, complete in as few as 24 months (4 semesters)
- 124 credits total
 - 5 core nursing courses (18 credits)
 - 4 elective courses (12 credits)
 - 72 credits awarded for an active, unencumbered U.S. Registered Nurse license
 - Up to 22 credits for portfolio experiences awarded for professional nursing certifications or prior courses taken that were not required by the RN program where the degree was awarded; otherwise requirement is met by additional electives courses
- Asynchronous lesson delivery and coursework
